BUS & TRAIN with the GUEST MOBILITY TICKET

1 Where is the ticket valid?

On all buses in the Province of Salzburg (including Salzburg city buses and trolleybuses), on all ÖBB trains without restriction (including DB ICE trains), on WESTbahn trains and on Salzburg local railways (Flachgau, Pinzgau).

2 Cross-border travel

Cross-border routes operated by the Salzburg Transport Association can be used with the Guest Mobility Ticket.

This applies to routes 260 and 180 (Pinzgau via Bad Reichenhall), 150 (Bad Ischl) and 546 (St. Wolfgang).

3 Dogs travel free

One dog per person and Guest Mobility Ticket may travel free of charge.

Please observe leash and muzzle requirements and the applicable conditions of carriage!

4 Bicycle not included

A bicycle ticket is required on regional trains (R, R3, R9, S-Bahn, REX). On long-distance trains (IR, EC, IC, RJ/RJX, ICE, D), a bicycle ticket and reservation are required. On regional buses, the driver decides whether space permits bicycle transport (buy ticket on the bus).

Parking at the station:

The GMT is a regular public transport ticket, like the KlimaTicket Salzburg or a single ticket. Your number plate is recorded electronically when entering the car park. For free exit (up to 3 days), scan the GMT QR code. With a valid GMT, parking is free through day 6; after that it costs €3.00 per day. You may leave within 15 minutes without a ticket. Exit only after the light briefly turns green!

Exit when the light is red:

If you exit on red or the system fails, e-mail info@apcoa.at within 48 hours of exiting: date, time, number plate and a photo/scan of the valid ticket.
